

Happy Trails Hosts Animal Emergency Rescue Seminar: Animal Rescue 101

Happy Trails is hosting the first in a series of seminars on animal emergency rescue, with the first 2-part class being held on Friday, Sept. 19th from 5pm to 8pm (day 1) and then continued on Saturday, Sept. 20th from 12:00pm to 5pm (day 2). This class is



mandatory for Happy Trails staff and volunteers who currently serve on the Happy Trails Animal Rescue Team. The material is designed to provide emergency rescue workers such as humane agents and law enforcement officials with the information needed to conduct a successful animal rescue and to handle the scene with professionalism and confidence. However, anyone interested in learning more about

animal rescue is welcome to register. This is a great seminar for those who may want a better understanding of farm animal rescue.

Topics that will be addressed include: organizing a rescue; to remove or not to remove the animals in question - assessing the health and condition of the farm animals; the chain of command at the scene of a rescue; setting up the staging area on-scene protocol - appropriate conduct for rescue workers at the property; being prepared with the correct supplies and emergency equipment; cataloging and documenting each animal; basic farm animal handling safety; dealing with the media; filing charges; preparing reports

This is the first seminar in a three-part series. Only those who attend this seminar will be permitted to sign up for the follow-up seminars, as they will be taught in succession. Happy Trails Animal Rescue 101 will give you the knowledge needed to understand the content of and the opportunity to register to attend Happy Trails Animal Rescue 102 and 103 seminars.
