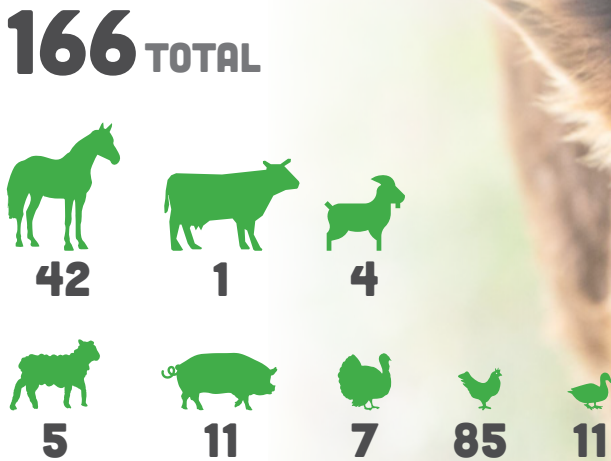
Our Mission

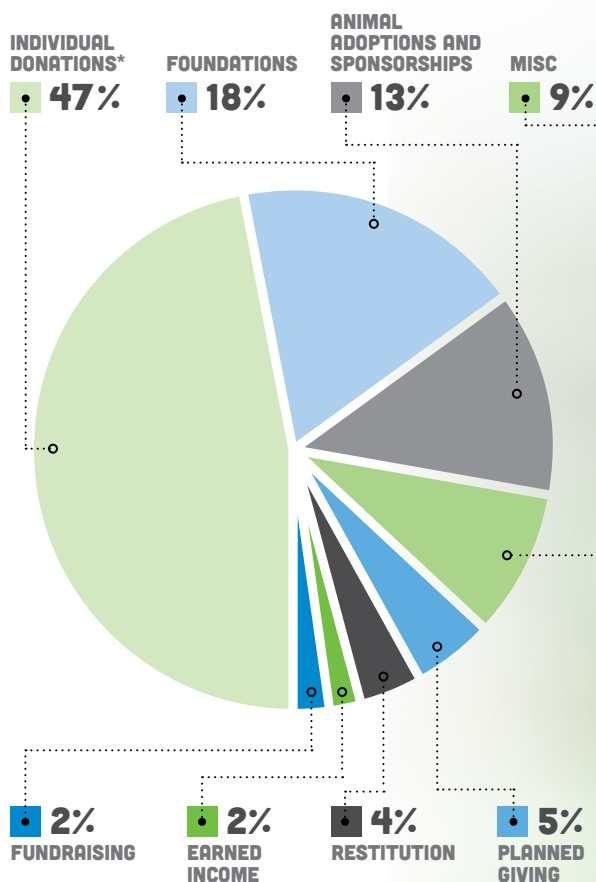
