

Visitor Protocol

Happy Trails Farm Animal Sanctuary, Inc strives to create an environment for our visitors that is safe, welcoming and enjoyable for all. In order to achieve these goals for our guests and assure the health and safety of the animals, we require that you read and agree to the following visitor protocol.

Pets are not allowed. When vising the sanctuary, we understand the need for a service dog. If this is the case, please call ahead. For the safety of visitors, pets and the sanctuary animals, pets are not allowed beyond the second gate of the property.

Feeding the animals is prohibited. The dietary needs of each animal at Happy Trails are regularly evaluated, and all diets are tailored to each animal's specific needs. Feeding outside food could potentially be detrimental to the health of an animal.

Only vegan food is allowed on the premises. Happy Trails encourages compassion for all animals. Out of respect for the rescued animals, we ask that any food brought onto the grounds be free of any animal products.

Do not take pictures of the animals without prior consent from a staff member. Some of the animals at Happy Trails are currently involved in active court cases, and taking or posting pictures of these animals online could potentially compromise a legal case against animal abuse offenders.

Dress for the environment. All tours at Happy Trails take place primarily outdoors, so please dress for the weather. Also keep in mind that even when the weather is good, many areas may be very muddy and the ground may be uneven. Boots are highly recommended, and no open toed shoes or sandals are permitted.

Do not interact with the animals unless accompanied and instructed by a guide. For your safety, please follow your guide's instructions when interacting with animals. Please closely supervise children at all times.
