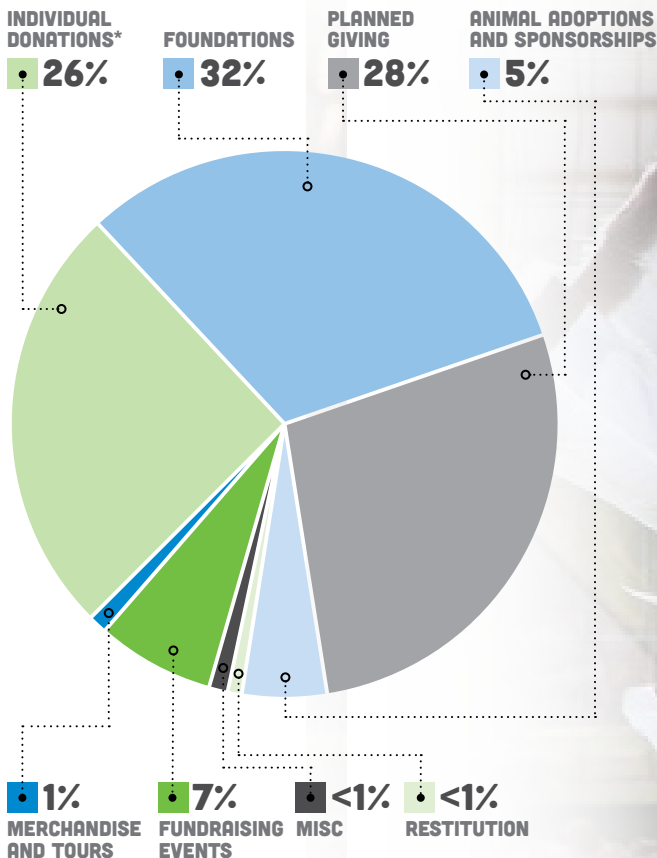
# Financial Summary
